Mission Statement

The Montgomery County Suicide Prevention Coalition will review, assess and make recommendations on findings that could reduce and/or prevent children, adolescents and adult suicides in Montgomery County.

Vision

To provide effective suicide prevention information that raises awareness about life saving resources in the county.

Coalition's Priorities

- To enhance the ability of people to recognize suicidal individuals and make appropriate referrals.
- Collect information on suicides to conduct follow-up studies to identify prevention strategies.
- Maintain a local inventory of existing programs, services, and other community resources that directly address known or suspected risks and protective factors to be established.
- Issue a call to the county for a sense of shared responsibility for implementing a prevention-based response to the problem of suicide.
- Convene community forums that engage multiple sectors of the community and invite each to share responsibility.
