How To Safely Store & Dispose of Medications



Store your medication in the original container and out of sight.



Keep medication in a locked container and out of reach of children and pets.



It is important to safely dispose of any unused or remaining pills.



Read the materials that came with your prescription to see if there are any special instructions for disposing of unused medication.



Take advantage of local drug take back events or medication drop boxes near you, listed on back side of this card.



Dispose of unused medications in the trash with an unpleasant substance such as coffee grounds or cat litter.



Pick up a free medication disposal pouch at Goodwill Stores in Montgomery County.
